**God has given the grace needed so His children can finish the ministry they have received from the Lord Jesus.**

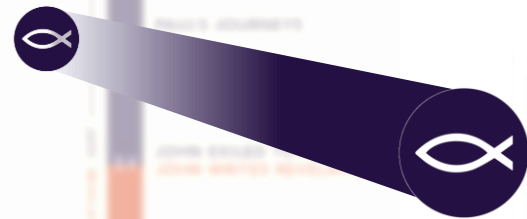
